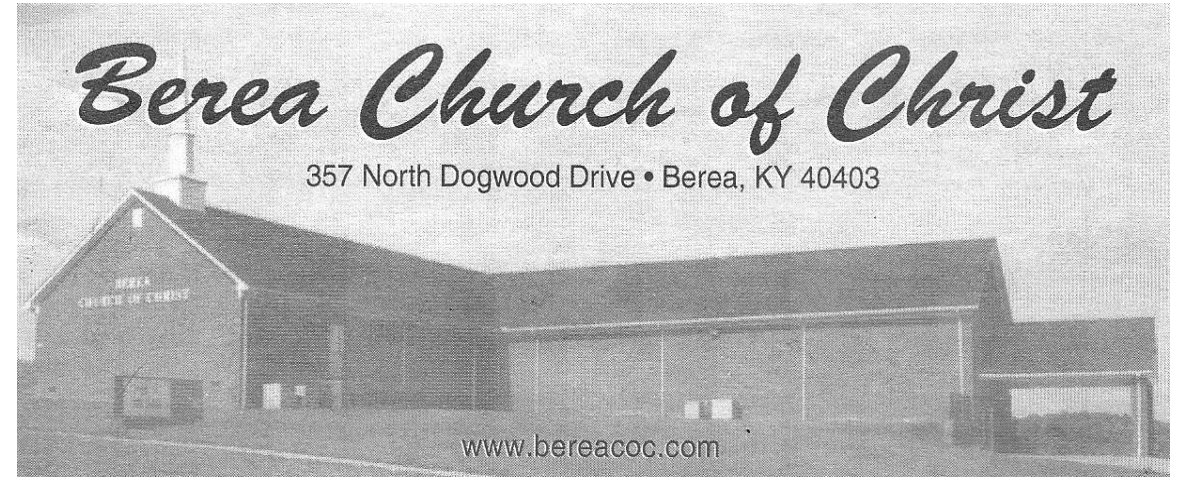

JOSIAH - A YOUTH WHO SERVED GOD

Josiah was a part of the Southern Kingdom, Judah. He did not have much encouragement from his grandfather (Manasseh) or his father (Amon). His grandfather set up altars to Baal and did evil [II Kings 21:2-3] and his father worshipped idols and did evil [II Kings 21:20-22]. Josiah, from his earliest age of accountability "did right in the eyes of Jehovah, and walked in the way of David his father" [II Kings 22:2]. He served as King for 31 years, beginning at the age of eight [II Kings 22:1].

Josiah determined early to "remember his Creator" [Ecclesiastes 12:1]. He allowed no man to despise his youth [I Timothy 4:12]. Josiah "turned not aside to the right hand nor to the left" [II Kings 22:2]. He was steadfast [I Corinthians 15:58], not allowing the pressures of politics, nor the influence of his friends, to turn his head from the truth. He did not deviate from God's will [Matthew 7:21-23] and always put God first [Matthew 6:33].

Josiah sought early in life to learn the law of God [II Kings 22:8]. He had a tender heart [II Kings 22:19]. Josiah wanted all people to obey the Lord [II Kings 22:11]. He even sought to teach the Word to all [II Kings 23:1].

Think of what a young person can do:

1. He can restore God's law to his life, his family and his associates.
2. He can be a power against evil and perversion.
3. He can receive God's wondrous grace - salvation, peace of mind and strength.
4. He needs to realize that apostasy is but one generation away potentially. Josiah

was one of Judah's last hopes.

May our young people be a Josiah!!!
